- understands and endorses that the Government of Alberta recognizes the legal duty to consult Indigenous communities and peoples rests with the Crown but when consultation relates to specific projects, the law allows the Crown to delegate procedural aspects of consultation to project proponents; and,
- recognizes and affirms that Aboriginal and treaty rights as well as traditional uses of land must be taken into consideration in decisions that relate to our assets, operations and project ventures.

Commitments

Athabasca Minerals will:

- tailor our consultation efforts to be sensitive to the culture, protocols and aspirations of each individual Indigenous community *potentially affected by our proposed projects*;
- balance the incorporation of traditional ecological knowledge, local community knowledge and science in decisions that relate to our businesses and operations;
- consult and engage Indigenous peoples and their communities *potentially affected by our proposed projects* early and often;
- provide Indigenous peoples and their communities with clear, timely, accurate and accessible information regarding our assets, operations and project ventures;
- mitigate and reduce, to the best of our ability, the potential adverse effects of our activities on the Aboriginal and treaty rights or traditional use of lands by Indigenous peoples and their communities; and,
- encourage and promote initiatives that increase employment and business opportunities for Indigenous peoples and their communities both within our company and our contractors.
